

Jamie Routley, RP

Born in Newport, South Wales in 1982, Jamie Routley was educated entirely through the Welsh language at Ysgol Gyfun Gwynllyw. He went on to earn a BA (Hons) in Illustration from Swindon College before moving to Florence, Italy in 2004 to study classical painting under American artist Charles H. Cecil (2004–2008). After a brief period living in Sweden and Wales, he settled in London in 2009, where he currently lives with his wife and two young daughters.

Jamie's work has been exhibited widely in prestigious group exhibitions, including the National Portrait Gallery's Portrait Award, the Royal Society of Portrait Painters, Figurativas at MEAM Barcelona, The Columbia Threadneedle Prize, and The Ruth Borchard Self-Portrait Prize.

His accolades include the Young Artist Award from the National Portrait Gallery's Portrait Award, the De Lazlo Foundation Award for Excellence from the Royal Society of Portrait Painters, an Honourable Mention at Figurativas 17 (MEAM, Barcelona), and an Exceptional Merit Award from the Portrait Society of America. In 2019, his self-portrait was acquired by The Ruth Borchard Collection, the UK's only public collection dedicated to self-portraiture.

In 2022, Jamie was elected a member of the Royal Society of Portrait Painters.

He also serves as a council member of the Artists' General Benevolent Institution (AGBI), one of the UK's oldest charities, supporting professional artists and their dependents across England, Wales, and Northern Ireland in times of financial hardship.

Artist Statement

"Concept is at the forefront of my work. My objective is to understand who I'm painting and develop the ideas before beginning the final piece. The process begins with gathering information—spending time with the sitter in and out of the studio, making studies, and collecting reference material. Through this, the aesthetic and compositional direction begins to take shape until I reach what I consider the true starting point."

Jamie's studio is located in West London, but he is always open to working on location if it better serves the sitter—and ultimately, the painting. While working from life remains his default, he integrates tools such as oil studies, mannequins, photographs, and video to streamline the process without compromising the integrity of the final work.

"My intention is always to make a painting in its own right, rather than a portrait. This may sound pedantic, but I think there's a significant difference. Not to diminish the portrait element, but hopefully to elevate it. I want the work to be able to exist anywhere."
